1. LIGHT



Replace all light fixtures with "dark skies" fixtures and install LED Lighting. These fixtures eliminate glare and shadows that make it easy for trespassers to hide. LED lighting allows true colors to be seen at night.

2. RECORD



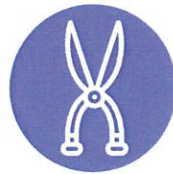
Surveillance is your 24/7 witness to help law enforcement catch criminals. Invest in quality surveillance with remote viewing. Place cameras inside and outside business.

3. LOCK



Keep your dumpsters locked and inside enclosures. Unlocked dumpsters can invite unwanted trespassers and activity. Any outdoor power supplies should also be locked to deter unwanted users.

4. TRIM



Eliminate hiding areas and open the line of sight to increase natural surveillance. Branches and hedges should not block your business visibility. Unkempt landscaping can provide trespassers with space to hide.
